Fiberglass

Lightweight - Considerably more durable than other planter materials - Rot and insect-proof; won't crack, chip, or warp - Weather-proof in any climate, including heat and freezing conditions - Available in a range of styles, from traditional to modern - Available in several colors and finishes, including high gloss and real metal - Most styles include drainage holes - Watertight options available - Easily customizable



Cellular PVC Composite

Looks and feels like wood, but more durable - Rot and insect-proof; won't crack, chip, or warp - Inherently white (no painting necessary), with 25+ finish and texture options - Matches Cape Cod-style homes and transitional décor - Maintenance-free



Fiberstone

Combines the durability of stone with the lightweight nature of fiberglass, making them easy to move and position - Strong and resistant to cracking, fading, and weathering, ensuring longevity in outdoor environments - Low Maintenance: Requires minimal upkeep, as the material is easy to clean and resistant to mold and mildew - Provides a sleek, natural stone-like appearance, making it ideal for both modern and traditional settings.



Vinyl

Lightweight - Double-walled construction (good for insulating plants from high heat and freezing temperatures) - Most styles have built-in reservoirs, making them self-watering, watertight - Fade-resistant construction - Maintenance-free



Corten Steel

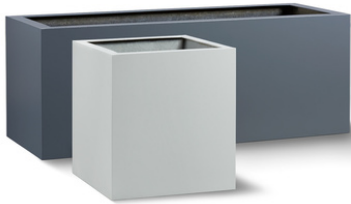
Natural rust patina develops with exposure - Rugged and low-maintenance - Ideal for modern, industrial, and urban styles - Built to last in all weather conditions



GFRC

Much lighter than traditional concrete, while retaining a solid, concrete-like appearance - Highly resistant to cracking, chipping, and wear, offering long-lasting performance in various environments - Withstands extreme weather conditions such as freezing, thawing, and UV exposure without damage

Square & Rectangle Planters

Can be used as space dividers
Great for lining walkways, patios, decks, rooftop decks, pools, and balconies. A space-saving way to add greenery to small spaces -

Round Planters

Can be used as space dividers

Low Bowl Planters

Low bowls can be placed on pedestals, pillars, and columns without blocking sightlines - Some manufacturing limitations



Urn Planters

Small Planters

Perfect for flowers and plants with shallow root systems
Hold less water and soil dries out faster - Great as small design accents; won't overwhelm the space



Large Planters

Great for trees and other plants with deep root systems and continued growth - Ideal for mixed plantings - Holds more soil and water than smaller planters; soil stays moist longer - Ideal for larger spaces, creating barriers, and for making a visual impact
